ADVOCACY TIPS

- Ask a transfer student to share their story; what drew them to the UW? What did they learn from their previous institution and how will they apply that knowledge here?
- Ensure that language on your websites and publications is inclusive of transfer students, by highlighting transfer-specific services and processes. For example: A transfer tab on your home page, transfer admissions timeline, or inclusive language such as using “previous school” instead of “high school”.
- Create a space on your applications for a student to indicate that they have transferred to the UW. This can give context to less UW specific student involvement or engagement on campus or in the community.
